- 100% of staff will engage in PD on the purposeful use of data in the classroom so that the DATA accurately relects and informs the pedalogical direction of the school.

- Employ and build capability of staff to provide focused and intensive teaching of writing and reading
- Ensure a balanced approach to teaching that incorporates a variety of teaching strategies, carefully selected materials and activities and needs-based teaching.
